The left hand grabs the ear first. Notice how the index finger and thumb of the left. hand are positioned on the shank. The middle finger, ring finger and little finger of the left hand remain open until the Hanging hook has opened up the shucks.

Here the right hand is coming back across the shucks to open them up.

> Now the right hand has slid around the ear and the fingers of the left hand should be closing tight on the shucks.

Here the right hand is pushing the ear forward and down while the left hand palm is rolling toward broken and the ear is the right hand and down. This is the motion that breaks the the right hand while ear from the shank. Maintain a tight grip on the shucks to clean them from the ear.

In this picture the shank should be ready to be tossed into the wagon with the left hand moves to the next ear.
